Tisha b'Av Schedule

1. Shabbos Mincha will be early, 5:35pm; a regular and complete Seudah Shlishis should be eaten; there will be no Seudah Shlishis at shul.
2. Stop eating by 7:55pm, say *hamavdil* and remove leather shoes at 8:45pm.
3. Maariv will be at 9:00pm, with Eicha and Kinnos at approximately 9:10pm.
4. Kinnos this year will be led and elucidated by Rabbi Josh Weinberger.
5. Sunday morning Shacharis and Kinos is at 8:00am, with Chatzos at 1:05pm.
6. Sunday Mincha is 7:30pm, Maariv is 8:09pm and the fast ends at 8:43pm.

One should not break one's fast until he/she has heard or said havdala (which consists of a beracha on a beverage and the bracha of, *Hamavdil bain kodesh l'chol, bain ohr l'choshech*).

Although the restrictions of the Nine Days are lifted immediately after the fast (since Tisha B'Av is *nidcheh* this year), one should still not play music or consume meat and wine (other than havdala) until Monday morning. Laundry, hair-cutting, and bathing are permissible Sunday night.
